

Job Opening: CA Inspector (Fish Food Safety Inspectors)

Marshall Islands Marine Resources Authority

Position Location: MIMRA Delap, Majuro Atoll

Duration: Two-year contract with a 6-month probationary period, with the possibility of extension subject to performance evaluation.

Purpose: MIMRA is seeking committed CA Inspectors to improve the Republic of the Marshall Islands' (RMI) sanitary controls of fish exports. This role ensures current exports to the USA, Thailand, and Taiwan maintain high standards, while actively establishing compliance to diversify and enter the European Union (EU) export market.

Position Responsibilities/Duties:

- **Inspections & Audits:** Undertake inspection, monitoring, and verification of fish processing plants, landing sites, and fishing vessels (including vessel boarding).
- **Compliance & Enforcement:** Evaluate fish processing operations for EU and international market readiness, and issue formal infringement or non-compliance notices when protocols are breached.
- **Testing & Certification:** Collect and submit biological/chemical samples for laboratory analysis, and validate or modify Health Certificates prior to export approval.
- **Administrative Support:** Work with the CA advisor to draft yearly work plans, participate in budgetary processes, record export metrics in the MIMRA database, and assist colleagues with catch data.

Education & Experience

- A Bachelor of Science degree in Food Science, Chemistry, Biology, Environmental Science, Food Law, or a similar related discipline.
- *Desirable:* Specialized qualifications in Food Technology or Food Law.

Skills:

- **Role-Specific Experience:** Proven experience working in a regulatory or manufacturing environment dealing with seafood/fish exports, the food industry, or environmental health.
- **Regulatory Knowledge:** A solid understanding of international export market requirements and the strict sanitary compliance frameworks needed for global trade.

- Technical Proficiency: Fluent in verbal and written English, proficient in MS Excel and Word, and possessing a demonstrated ability to write high-quality technical inspection reports.
- Personal Traits: Strong communication skills, a high level of professional commitment, and a strong willingness to learn new technical skills and undergo ongoing upskilling.
